

Getting to Padua



By air

Padua can be easily reached from three **airports** (Venice VCE, Treviso TSF, Verona VRN).

The nearest airport is **Venice Marco Polo** (60 Km) where many national and international airlines operate.

The airports of **Treviso** (70 Km) and **Verona** (80 Km) are also close enough and provide easy access.

By train

Padova is at a key point on the Turin-Trieste and Venice-Rome rail routes and is consequently well served by the rail network. It is about two hours from Milan, 1 hour from Bologna and 30 minutes from Venice and Verona.

By car

From the **A4 Torino-Trieste motorway**, take the **Padova Est exit**, whether coming from Milan (west) or from Venice (east); from here follow the signs to the centre of Padova.

From the **A13 Bologna-Padova motorway**, take the **Padova Sud exit**, then follow the signs to the centre of Padova.

Getting around Padua

PUBLIC TRANSPORTATION

Bus and tram services in Padua are provided by **FSBusItalia**.

The price of a single 75-minute ticket is €1.30 at the ticket office or €2.50 on board; a 24h ticket costs €3.60.

TAXI

Cooperativa Radio Taxi Padova is a 24-hour radio taxi service. Taxi rank in the centre of Padua Train Station square.
